Overview: No organization can do all its works itself. From time to time, need arises to hire external agencies having the requisite technical/ managerial capabilities to deliver the required services in the most cost- effective manner. Tendering is a method of procurement of specific works and/or services in a transparent manner while giving equal opportunity to all eligible interested parties. Contracts and their management are the critical second stage of the process. A meticulously drafted tender and contract agreement is the key to ensure conflict free delivery of required quality of work in a time bound and effective manner.



Objectives of Course: The objective of the course is to provide the necessary inputs which go into making of a good tender document and a meticulous Contract Agreement. The programme also aims to provide the officer not just information, but also an understanding of the recent technological developments in the field of procurement, such as GeM. The course intends to impart an understanding of Railway rules and regulations in the field and expose the participants to the best practices in the area. Besides, it is a forum for sharing of field experiences with the objective to enrich each other and extract value from each other's approaches to issues faced.

Brief Content and Delivery: The programme will cover all important aspects such as Earning Contracts, IREPS, GST, Latest Development in GEM, IMMS, GCC-Works & Services, Transparency in Procurement, Vigilance Perspective, Management of Sanitation, Housekeeping and OBHS Contracts, Integrated Material Management System, Schedule of Power and Role of Finance in Tenders & Contracts, Indian Contract Act-1872, and Arbitration & Conciliation Act-1996 etc.
