Program will cover topics like Introduction to and Essentials of Transport Economics and usefulness of Statistics, Costing and Rating of various Passenger and Freight services, Analyzing productivity and performance indicators, Planning Railway services, Allocation of Resources, Various modes of Financing including Extra-budgetary resources, Challenges and Innovations in making Transport services viable and profit making, etc.


Nomination :
